



Between 2005 and 2007 the PAC resources increased by \$6,962. Between 2008 and 2011 the PAC resources have been steadily declining by over \$5,000. In 2012 we have reversed the trend of using up our resources, and we have increased the Club resources in 2012 by \$872 and by \$1,496 in 2013. We have reduced the number of events in 2013, but we were successful with them as organizers, and as Board exercised fiscal responsibility. Our Pacanow "school" is regularly attended by group of 15-20 kids every Saturday.

The Polish American Club gained quite a few new members and increased its membership from 42 (individual and family memberships) in 2012 to 55 memberships in good standing in 2014 (January figures) 31% increase.

2013 has been a successful year as we expanded our membership, we have strengthen our fiscal position (increased resources), improved the appeal of PAC events to the **Polish American Community** (increased membership), and successfully implemented technology to help us become more efficient, transparent and compliant (professional newsletter and event registration services), and to help the Club and the entire Community look more professional.
